TRUSTEES OF TRUST FUNDS

July 19, 2023

In attendance: Jan Cole, Karen Foss, Mike Betley and Carol Walker

The meeting commenced at 4:00 pm.

<u>There were no transaction activities (other than payment of the Three Bearings Advisory fees noted below) in June 2023</u> for either the Capital Reserve Fund (CRF) or the Common Trust Fund (CTF).

The Trustees reviewed the June 1- 30, 2023 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Capital Reserve Fund (CRF) report with a beginning balance of \$2,494,065.47 on 6/1/2023. In June, there was a \$13,707.20 increase in the CRF investment value, net of dividend income of \$4,438.31 and after deduction of the Three Bearings Advisor fee of \$2,849.98 that was paid in June (even though it was accrued and accounted for on May's MS-9). The ending account value was \$2,504,922.69 at 6/30/2023. On a year-to-date basis, there has been an increase of \$86,826.50 in the CRF Investment value.

The Trustees reviewed the June 1-30, 2023 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Trust Fund (CTF) report with a beginning balance of \$307,551.65 on 6/1/2023. In June, there was an increase of \$6,067.98 in the CTF investment value, net of dividend income of \$1,682.20 and after Three Bearings Advisor fee of \$351.44 that was paid in June (even though it was accrued and accounted for on May's MS-9). The ending account value was \$313,268.19 at 6/30/2023. On a year-to-date basis, there has been an increase of \$6,906.30 in the CTF Investment value.

The MS-9's for the periods from 1/01/2023 through 6/30/2023 and 6/1/2023 to 6/30/2023 were reviewed; dividends earned in June were included as noted above.

<u>Minutes</u>: Draft minutes for the June 28, 2023 trustee meeting were reviewed. Jan made a motion to approve the minutes as written with a second by Karen. The motion passed unanimously. Carol will send the final approved minutes for June's meeting to the Town Administrator and Secretary for posting to the Town's website. Mike suggested revised wording for summarizing monthly activity for the Three Bearings/Fidelity Trust fund reports that will be utilized beginning with the July 2023 reports.

Other business:

<u>Lafayette School Building & Grounds Maintenance Fund</u>: Toni Butterfield has sent a check for \$70,000 to be deposited to this fund per Lafayette Regional School District Annual Meeting on 3/9/2023 Warrant Article 4. Jan will follow up with Toni to find out when the school expects to use these funds so that it can be invested appropriately (short or long term).

<u>Franconia Scholarship Award</u>: Lily Pospesil has submitted the information required in order to have her scholarship award funded. The check request will be signed by the BOS at the 7/24/23 meeting.

<u>Automated External Defibrillator (AED) purchase</u>: One of the two AEDs the town is purchasing will be located at Franconia Market.

<u>New Town Administrator</u>: Jan will meet with Libby to review the process to request reimbursement, go over the DRA portal, chart of accounts, and review important dates that certain DRA documents must be filed as well as department budgets, and other financial matters.

<u>Cemetery funding, perpetual care and sale of cemetery plots</u>: We are still waiting for proceeds from additional plots sold in 2022 as well as any that that have been sold thus far in 2023 so that funds can be transferred to the Cemetery Maintenance Fund CRF. A review of CT minutes for 2023 indicates that topics raised by the TOTF have been postponed to a future date.

<u>Funds to transfer to & from CRFs & ETFs question</u>: Steve Plant, Town Treasurer, supports the transfer of funds approved at Town meeting now that the first tax payments have been collected and agrees with the process that Jan has outlined.

<u>Franconia Heritage Museum</u>: Jan has learned that Barbara Holt gave \$10,000 to the Heritage Museum with a restriction that it be used for the Iron Foundry display; as a result, the Wooden Thumb bill that was submitted for reimbursement will come from funds gifted by Barbara Holt. Donations and funds from taxation must not be combined. If donations are restricted by the donor, then this must be communicated to the Trustees for correct accounting.

There being no further business, the trustees adjourned the meeting at 5:45 pm. Since there will be no meeting in August due to vacations, the next scheduled meeting will be on September 20, 2023 at the Town Hall beginning at 4 pm.
