Franconia N.H. Winter Parking Ban Ordinance

The Town of Franconia NH Winter Parking Ban Ordinance Is In effect From October 15, through 15 April of every year.

The Town of Franconia NH has a Winter parking ban ordinance in place to assist the winter maintenance program (I.E. Snow Removal and Emergency Services)

The Town of Franconia NH Winter Parking Ban Ordinance States as follows. There shall be No parking on any street, road, lane or in the turn a rounds for which the Town Provides maintenance. From 15 October through 15 April of every year. Vehicles will be towed at the owners expense and a fine up to a \$100.00 maybe imposed.

The Selectmen, Planning Board or designee with respect to ways under there jurisdiction may place signs (But do not have to) prohibiting or restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any way where in there opinion such stopping, standing or parking is dangerous to those using the way or where the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic thereon. Such signs shall be official signs and no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on such signs. (No Parking \$100.00 Fine Vehicle Towed at Owners Expense)
